While fostering rescue dogs is a rewarding experience it is also a commitment. You are responsible for the care and shelter of the dog that you choose to foster. A foster parent accepts a dog into their home with the understanding that it may require a three-day or four month commitment. The length of stay in a foster home is indefinite and can vary. The average placement time for a dog is 3 to 6 weeks. It could be shorter or it could be longer depending on the dog, where you live, and on what the adopters are looking for in a dog at that time. Some dogs, like bully breeds, those with medical needs or behavioral issues , may be slow to be adopted. A foster parent is one who makes a commitment to a dog and sees that commitment through.
